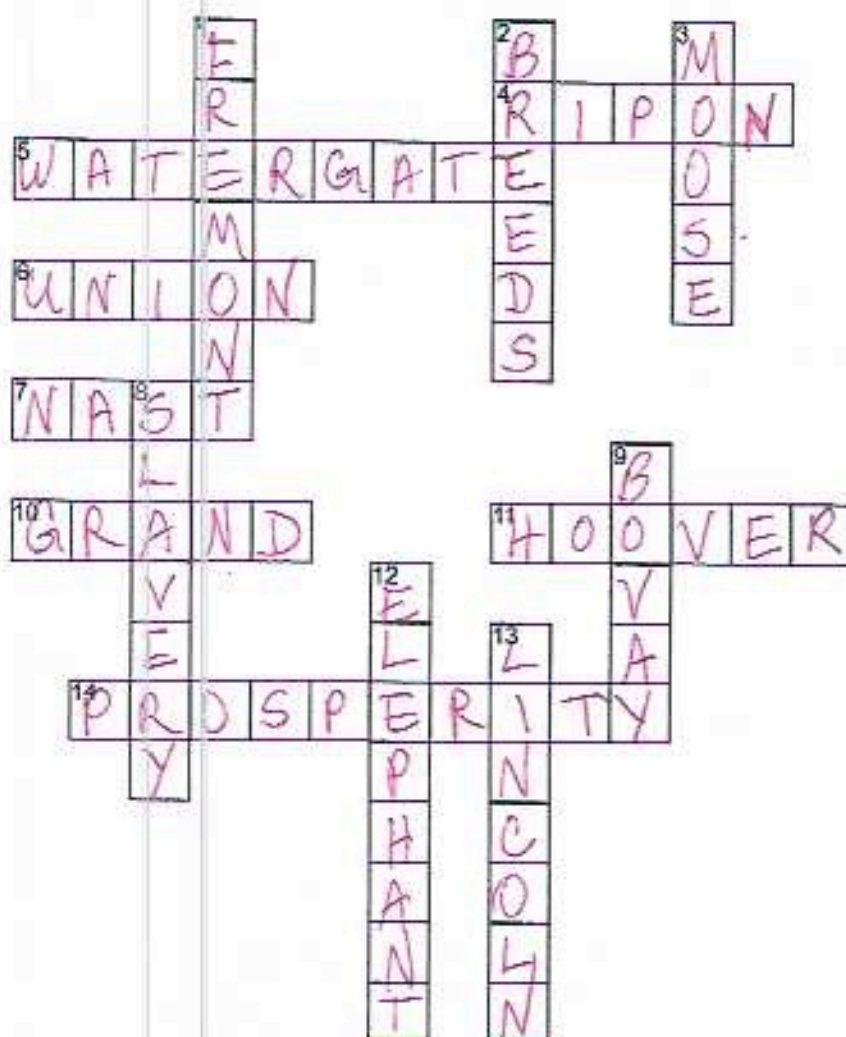


## The Republican Party
